Additionally, 55.6% of the respondents were considered to be first-time College Students.

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

ADVISING




When asked about their advising at PSU, the survey respondents reported that 83.3% of them were correctly advised during their academic journey. 16.7% did not think they were correctly advised.

The survey respondents reported that 30.6% of them had employment lined up after graduating from PSU. 69.4% reported that they did not have employment lined up after graduation.







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ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE




When asked whether they were adequately prepared to communicate orally, 97.2% of them agreed.




Regarding Research, 97.2% agreed that their academic programs prepared them well to conduct scholarly research.

When the survey respondents were asked whether their academic departments prepared them to write clearly and effectively, 100% of them agreed that they have been adequately prepared.




Regarding Critical Thinking, 100% agreed that their academic programs prepared them adequately to think critically.
